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Dear Clients,

We would like to first extend our thanks to everyone for understanding our cancellation of scheduled appointments. Along with everyone in the country, we are considering the safety of the office as well as of our clients. That being said, we are still open and working.

Secondly, we want to address yesterdays' announcements from the Federal government and the State of Connecticut regarding tax deadlines under these unusual circumstances. The Treasury Secretary announced on March 17, 2020 that if there was a balance due upon completion of your Form 1040 of \$1,000,000 or less, payment would not be required until 90 days later.

Secretary Treasury Mnuchin did not extend the due date of filing the individual form 1040 beyond April 15, 2020. If the individual 1040 return cannot be completed by April 15, 2020 an extension on filing the individual return can be taken.

At this time the State of Connecticut is following the US Treasury guidelines for filing of the individual forms.

For CT business tax returns, Forms CT-1065/CT-1120 SI, that were due on or after March 15, 2020, the State extended the due date of those returns until April 15, 2020 and payment of the Pass Thru entity tax, if applicable, to June 15, 2020.
